Comedy Test Script

Beginning of Comedy Test scene

(A close up shot of Samuel's legs are shown running, He is out of breath and is hesitating)

Samuel – What's the time? Oh Great! I'm going to be late again! I hope Officer Bruce isn't mad at me again!

(Samuel then rushes to the door; he opens the handle and ends up in Bruce's Office. Bruce's face shows that he is frustrated due to Samuel being late)

Bruce – This is the sixth time you've been late Samuel! The manager's I work have would have kicked me out by now!

(Samuel says his line in a tired and exhausted voice)

Samuel – Sorry Officer Bruce it won't happen again.

(Bruce sys at this point)

Bruce – Hurry and take a seat.

(Samuel takes a seat and Bruce momentarily thinks about something)

Bruce – Anyway. How are you Today Samuel?

(Samuel responds in a calm and composed voice)

Samuel - I'm very well thank you. Did you watch news about Brexit talk dates?

Bruce – Oh yes! The talks are taking place at the end of March aren't they?

(Samuel nods his head as he is hesitating)

Samuel - Possibly.

(Bruce is confused as he says his line)

Bruce – Possibly? Have they organized a proper date yet?

Samuel - No, the dates for Brexit talks are so poorly disorganized.

(Bruce nods)

Bruce – Definitely. Being organized is a tough job to do! But in the world of politics many politicians are on different levels. The Top politicians look down on the lower one's and see them as being committed and positive people for the job they are doing! But the lower politicians see the Best one's as being nothing but nasty and narrastic pricks!

(Samuel agrees with Bruce's opinion)

Samuel – Indeed! The example I think of is Nigel Farage! Since breakfast! All he has done is just ruin people's lives.

Bruce – Yes! He's turned our ordinary and decent lives. Into nothing but trash!

Bruce – But enough of brekkie talks for now! Samuel, you know why you are here today!

(Samuel's face becomes confused)

Samuel – Yes, why am I here?

Bruce – Do you want to know?

Samuel – Yes

Bruce – You are being moved from your job in our local government, to have a job in the national government!

(A crash zoom shows Samuel's shocked face and he shouts as he says his line)

Samuel – What!

Bruce – Oh yes you are! I'll ring up your manager martin, so he can be here to explain your promotion.

(Bruce throws his phone in his hand and dials a number)

(Martin Comes in)

Martin – Hello Samuel. How are you today!

(Samuel hesitates as he says his line)

Samuel – I'm very well thank you

Martin – Good! We have thought for a while about whom we would like to promote to take on the job in the national government. And we choose you!

Bruce – Yes! The decision was hard and tough. But in the end you were the most likely to take on this job.

(Samuel mumbles as he says his line)

Samuel - I feel like you two aren't giving me enough details about why I'm being promoted. So, why did you choose me to promote me?

Martin – We believe you can expand your abilities in the world of politics and take on much tougher jobs!

Bruce – Yes, just imagine it. You being a top politician and being in charge of breakfast talks!

Martin – Maybe, you can organize a debate in the House of Commons. To discuss If Donald duck trump should be allowed to visit the UK!

(Samuel looks at his friends with an awkward and complexed face)

Samuel – Okay... But I don't believe I can take on this job! I prefer doing work for our local government!

Martin – I don't think you understand. You have such a golden, glamour's and brilliant opptunity to have an exciting career ahead of you!

Samuel – Sir, I don't think I will be good for this job! It's not for me! Why can't Brendan or Edward be promoted! Why can't they have the job!

(Martin and Bruce look at each other and nod)

Bruce – Brendan has only just started working for our local government. But, I think he will have to wait for his promotion. We're not promoting him because he's too obsessed with Nick clegg leg. We both hate that moron; he failed miserably to get people to vote for him as the next prime minister. Just goes to show what a waste of time that idiot was! Until Brendan can get over of his stupid obsession with Cleggy, we're not promoting him yet!

Martin – Don't get me started on Edward! He's obsessed with the former labor party's leader Ed milibad! If Edward get's promoted to the national government. He'll probably end up being the leader for the labour party.

Bruce – Don't forget his favourite sandwich

Martin – Oh yes Bacon sandwich. If Edward does become a labour party leader we will need to tell him to stop eating bacon sandwiches. Otherwise, he'll end up just being on the tabloids like ED mibilbad and be a joke on the internet. Bruce – Anyway, we don't want to promote anyone who's obsessed with terrible and idiotic former party leaders. We need someone fresh and new. So we are choosing you whether you like it or not.

Martin – By the way Samuel, the big old boss is going to come in and give you more details about your promotion.

(Samuel once again hesitates as he says his line)

Samuel – Why does big boss have to come in for? I'll end up just having a long conversation with him. He once kept in this office for 2 hours! I don't want that to happen again!

(Samuel becomes slightly frustrated after he says his line)

Bruce – We don't care. This will make our talk a lot easier.

Martin – I feel the same way. It will make our lives a lot easier.

(Raymond enters and open's the door while smiling)

Raymond – I'm right on time. Samuel! I assume your colleges have informed you about your promotion?

(Raymond walks up to the desk and shakes Samuel's hand)

Samuel – Yes, they have given me the details about my promotion.

Raymond – Excellent! Now that im here everything will be much easier!

(Raymond walks to his desk and sits down)

Raymond – Oh I forgot to ask you Samuel. How are you today?

(Samuel becomes fed up with this question after being asked for the third times and says his line in a way that tries not to show his anger)

Samuel – Yes sir. Everything is brilliant so far.

Raymond – Excellent! Now then, I have agreed with others that you would be perfect for this job. I think you will have an excellent career in the national government.

Samuel – Sir, I want to ask once again. Why should I am a perfect candidate for this job. I prefer to stay local. Not stay in a city full of posh, loud and noisy idiots!

Raymond – London is a fantastic place! Yes some of the people are dull and annoying but Im sure you are ready to take on new challenges! You will be starting this Monday and your first task will be to organize breakfast talk dates!

(Samuel jumps from his chair and can no longer keep calm)

Samuel – Once again, I prefer to stay in our local government! I don't want to organize breakfast talk dates! Or do a debate if Donald Duck Trump should be allowed in the UK! Besides! Why don't you three go for this pathetic job role instead! (Samuel walks out out of the room in a heap. Raymond, Bruce and Martin start smiling as he exits out the room)

(Samuel stands momentarily and senses something strange is behind him)

Samuel – What!

(A crash zoom happens when Sam says his line. It then cuts to show a sign saying good luck. It then zooms out to show workers giving him the thumbs up)
